IFA Testing Pool (TP) 2015**

IFA Testing Pool (TP) 2015 effective as of 1 January 2015

Regarding to the IFA Anti-Doping regulation as laid down in the IFA Anti-Doping Rules based on Wada's Models of Best Practice for International Federations and the World Anti-Doping Code (valid from 1.1.2015) Article 5.6.6. IFA establishes a Testing Pool (TP) of 9 athletes based on the team results of the prior IFA World Championships plus a team member of the IFA World Championship hosting country federation.

According to Article 5.6.6. these 9 athletes nominated to the TP have to provide to IFA at least the following whereabouts information by ADAMS starting latest on 1 October 2015:

- **An up-to-date mailing and e-mail address,**
- **Training whereabouts (including usual training venue/s addresses and usual timing of the training) and**
- **All national team activities (including training, camps and matches with accurate schedules and addresses)**
