

The matches take place from Tuesday 24 July 2018 to Saturday 28 July 2018.

The World Championship finishes with the final banquet dated Sunday 29 July 2018

1. Substitution of an ill/injured player

The substitution of an ill/injured player is possible until the beginning of the tournament, but the players must have been announced at the long list provided by 31 May 2018.

2. Regulations

The IFA Competition Rules (IFCR) and the IFA Regulations World Championships form the basis for the event.

The matches will be carried out according to the currently valid version of the rules of the games – including the latest innovations.

3. Tournament Format / Drawing

1. Drawing

11 participating teams in the tournament, 5 teams form Group A, 6 teams form Group B. The nations and positions were drawn according to the results of the 2016 IFA Women's World Championship in Brazil.

2. Preliminary round (2 Groups A and B, best of 3 sets)

Matches of preliminary round are carried out in a round-robin system within the groups A and B, all of them being played best of 3 sets.

- The teams ranked 1 to 3 in their groups directly move on to the double elimination round (for positions 1-8),
- the teams ranked 4 and 5 move on to the qualifiers for the double elimination round.
- The team ranked 6 in group B moves on to the President's Cup.

3. Qualifiers (best of 5 sets)

The teams ranked second to seventh in their groups play a qualifier for the double elimination round according to the following format:

Q1: 4A vs 5B (Match 27) Q2: 4B vs 5A (Match 26)

- The winners of these matches move on to the double elimination round (for positions 1-8).
- The losers of these matches move on to the President's Cup (for positions 9-11)

4. President's Cup (for positions 9-11, best of 3 sets)

Matches of President's Cup are carried out in a round-robin system, all of them being played best of 3 sets.

- The teams ranked 1 and 2 enter the final of the President's Cup.
- The winner of this final will be ranked 9, the loser is ranked 10.
- The team ranked 3 in the President's Cup will be ranked 11.
- All matches of the President's Cup are being carried out best of 3 sets.
- The final will be best of 5 sets.

As the first semi-final is covered live by Austrian nation-wide television (ORF), a possible semi-final with Austria being involved will be the first one at 16:30. (That means in effect that match 42 and 43 might be exchanged)

This might also influence the matches 39 and 40: Austria or their possible opponent in the semifinals will carry out the first match of Double Elimination Round 3 (Losers). (That means in effect that match 39 and 40 might be exchanged)

The official schedule for 27 July will be published in the evening of 26 July.

That includes two full size warm up and training courts. Be prepared to make compromises in terms of size of the run outs of the courts.

The Organizing Committee (OC) takes over the costs for accommodation and full board for all referees.

Referee's Outfit at Women's World Championship:

IFA will provide new 2 Erima referee jerseys and 2 Erima T-Shirts for each referee at IFA 2018 Fistball Women's World Championship.

At official events like the Opening Ceremony please wear your referee's training jacket.

8. Jerseys

Every team must bring 2 sets of jerseys in different and contrasting colours. Coaches and substitute players wear shirts of a different colour than the team's colour. The dress colours have to be added to the file "Jersey colours".

The IFA Technical Delegate decides about the colours of the jerseys for the following day.

The coaches wear different colours than the players on the court. Regarding advertising the IFA Competition Rules (IFCR) valid from 11th November 2011 (clause 3.5) are applied.

9. Head of Delegations meeting

The Head of Delegations meeting is scheduled for Monday 23 July 2018; 17:00 in the press center at the venue.

10. Opening/Closing Ceremony (Banquet)

The official Opening Ceremony is scheduled for Tuesday 24 July 2017; 17:30.

There will be a marching in of the teams on the center court to a stage. After the marching in the athletes and officials will take a seat on the athletes' and volunteers' stand.

The teams of the following match will take place on Tuesday 24 July 2018, 18:15 will be able to warm up after the marching in as the match will start immediately after the Opening Ceremony (after not less than 30 minutes preparation time)

Details for the Closing Ceremony (Banquet) will be provided in the Head of Delegations meeting.

11. Arrival/Departure in/from Linz

OC will provide transfers to accommodation places from/to Airport Linz-Hörsching or Linz main station to/from the official hotel Sommerhaus.

Participants arriving to other locations are asked to get to accommodation place on their own. All participants who arrive to Airport Linz-Hörsching or Linz main station will be welcomed by a volunteer in the arrivals hall and directed to proper busses departing just to the official hotel.

12. Accreditation procedure

All the participants will be accredited upon their arrival at the official hotel Sommerhaus, teams having another accommodation also have to get their accreditations at the information desk in the official hotel. The accreditation card is personal, non-transferable and compulsory to gain access to the training and competition venues and the official hotel and its catering center if your team booked that arrangement. **Please note: No accredidation will be handed out without a photo of the player or official.** The photos will be exported out of the fistball.org-database.

The accreditation card identifies individuals participating at the IFA 2018 Fistball Women's World Championship and indicates their access rights to the different zones listed in the Accreditation Badge. Access control will be conducted at the entrance to restricted areas.

The Accreditation Badge allows free entrance to the center court on the athletes' and volunteers' stand (sector B) but please note that venue capacities are limited, so there are no reservations on the athletes' stands available.

The players have to sign the following agreement for their participation in the tournament when they get the accreditation:

If there is no photo or a photo in bad quality, **please understand that we don't provide any autograph cards for those people.**

The following programme is scheduled: **Monday, 23th July 2018:** From 17:00 – 18:30 Implementation of a training course for federations which are under development (BEL, SRB, POL, NZL).

Friday, 27th July 2018:

From 20:00 – 22:00: Implementation of a course of lectures as an information event Part 1: fistball education in the youth sector and in school sports with consideration of the different approaches in the member federations by lecturers from Germany, Switzerland and Austria. Part 2: presentation of the new IFA Fistball Academy
