3. Participation, Teams and Quota

The IFA 2020 Fistball U18 Men's and Women's World Championships and the EFA 2020 Fistball Men's European Championship Austria are open to all Federations affiliated to IFA as members, each of which can nominate one team. The players for the U18 competition have to be born in year 2002 or later, the players for the U21 competition have to be born in year 1999 or later.

The maximum quota is 16 teams in each competition. If more than 16 teams register for the event qualifiers according to quota for the Regional Associations have to be played.

Only Member federations that have fulfilled their financial liabilities to IFA will be admitted to the competitions.

Each team has to consist of up to ten players and up to 3 officials. Additionally, every Federation is allowed to nominate 1 Head of Delegation, who may also be one of the team officials.

4. Regulations

The IFA Competition Rules (IFCR) and the IFA Regulations World Championships form the basis for the event.

5. Match days and welcome banquet

The World Championships take place from Thursday 23 July 2020 to Sunday 26 July 2020. They end with the victory ceremony for all teams on Sunday 26 July 2020.

The U21 European Championship starts on Friday 24 July and ends on Saturday 25 July with the victory ceremony.

The World Championship starts with the welcome dinner on **Thursday 23 July 2020**. The organizers plan a player's party on Sunday 26 July after the victory ceremony.

6. Accommodation, board and Lodging for players and team officials

The competing teams will have to bear their own travelling expenses, accommodation and full board (except welcome dinner) for all team members.

- **Breakfast** will be provided in the official team hotels,
- **Lunch and dinner** will be provided at the playing fields.

The Organizers will arrange a per day cost for meals at cheap conditions. Teams can pay that arrangement at their arrival. Detailed information to the team catering will follow within the next Bulletins.

The school offers very cheap accommodations for all teams. There's a maximum of 100 beds available. There are rooms from 3 to 5 people and a few single rooms for coaches. The rooms are with shower and wash bins, toilets are on the hallway.

7. Deposit

At the team registration, the transfer to the account of the International Fistball Association (IFA) of a deposit of EUR 200 per team (each EUR 200 per women and men team) is required. The deposit is used to finance the costs for team catering. At the final invoice and full payment of the team catering in the beginning of the IFA 2020 Fistball Men's and Women's World Championships the deposit will be deducted from the total amount.

8. Transportation

On days of arrival and departure a free shuttle bus transfer from and to Airport Linz-Hörsching or the Grieskirchen-Gallspach Main Station will be at the disposal of the arriving / departing delegations.

A shuttle service from/to the official team accommodations from/to the venue is also provided.

9. Visa Information

EU nationals do not require a visa to enter the Federal Republic of Austria.

Generally speaking, all other foreigners require a visa for stays in Austria. A visa is not required for semi-annual visits of up to three months for nationals of those countries for which the European Community has abolished the visa requirement.

Nationals being in need for Visa to enter Austria are required to contact the respective Austrian embassy or consular section being responsible for your country.

Visas are issued by the mission responsible for the area in which the applicant has his/her ordinary residence or domicile.

Participants being in need for Visa are requested to register online as mentioned above prior to the deadlines given.

The Organizing Committee will upon request send invitation letters to the respective Federation.

The Organizers would like to underline that Visa procedures are the responsibility of the applying person/s. In any case but in particular in the case of late registration or failing respective procedures the Organizers are not responsible for the participant's visas. The Organizers however will be glad to assist when questions on Visa procedures should apply.

The Organizers would also like to stress strongly that no visas will be issued at the Austrian passport control and all documentation has to be prepared beforehand.

10. IFA Fistball Academy

Within the framework of the IFA 2020 Fistball U18 Men's and Women's World Championships Austria IFA will organize an IFA Fistball Academy for teachers and trainers as full day training program. The aim is to provide every participant a basis knowledge of training and the Rules of the Game.

The number of participants is limited. The participants have to bear a small attendance fee, travel costs to Grieskirchen and hosting.

The final date and further details will be provided as soon as possible.

11. IFA Youth Congress

The IFA Youth and Sports Commission is planning to organize the 3rd IFA Youth Congress within the framework of the World Championships. The aim of the IFA Youth Congress is to discuss and share the ideas of youth concepts from the IFA member federation to increase the youth appeal of Fistball. Details are provided in due time.
